The Indian National Flag is a symbol of national pride for the entire nation. To further honour the national flag, Govt. of India has planned the Har Ghar Tiranga program under Azadi ka Amrit Mahotsav activities. It envisages inspiring Indians everywhere to hoist the national flag.

The idea behind the initiative is to invoke the feeling of patriotism in the hearts of the citizens and promote awareness about our national flag. The program encourages students and their families towards hoisting the national flag during the independence week from August 13 to 15, 2022.

The Village International School, Thodupuzha is also becoming a partner with the country in spreading the awareness about the national flag among our stakeholders. We encourage our students to buy national flags from your nearby post offices and hoist at their residence during the independence week. The photographs of hoisting the flag must be sent to the concerned class teachers for uploading to CBSE.

The Village International School is inviting all the students and parents to participate in this initiative.

For this, some rules for hoisting the tricolour have been suggested. Those rules are as follows. -

- Every citizen should follow the tricolour flag code.
- While hoisting the tricolour flag, the orange colour should be on the upper side.
- While lowering the tricolour flag, it should be lowered carefully and respectfully.
- Flags to be planted under the initiative "Har Ghar Tiranga" from 13th August 2022 to 15th August 2022 and should be kept respectfully and safely after the campaign duration.
- The flag should not be thrown away after the campaign period. Save it.
- A half-bent, torn, cut flag should not be hoisted under any circumstances.

According to the given instructions, students should participate in this activity voluntarily.
