DAY WISE ITINERARY

Day 0:

Board train from Ernakulam. Date of journey would be 22 or 23 Jan as

approximate journey duration is 44 - 50 hours.

Day 1:

25 Jan –Train from Cochin to Delhi should reach Delhi on 25th before noon

A representative at the railway station will welcome the group and transit to the hotel

in an A/C Deluxe Bus. Rest and relax at the hotel in Delhi.

DAY 02: - 26ThJAN - REPUBLIC DAY PARADE-

CELEBRATING AND ATTENDING REPUBLIC DAY PARADE.

Buses will lead to the parking area close venue entrance early morning at 3.30 am.

Breakfast will be arranged.

After witnessing the Parade, proceed back to the hotel for lunch.

After lunch, shopping and Delhi tour is planned.

Breakfast and boarding the bus for the drive to Agra. A visit to the world famous Taj

Mahal built by the Mughal Emperor Shah Jahan in 1630 for his Queen Mumtaz to

enshrine her mortal remains. A visit to the Agra Fort containing the Pearl Mosque, the

Halls of Public and Private Audience. Afternoon drive to Delhi (210 Kms, 3 Hrs drive).

Lunch on the way. Stay in Hotels in Delhi.

DAY 04: - 28 JAN - Beating the Retreat Ceremony - Morning time short Visit of Delhi

the Retreat ceremony on January 29. It symbolizes retreat after a day on the battlefield

and features performances by bands of the three wings of the Indian military -- the

Army, Navy and Air Force. After beating retreat ceremony back to Hotel relax and night

in Hotel.

DAY 05: - 29IAN- After a leisurely breakfast Drive Through New Delhi Darshan, a city

designed and built by the British in the 1920s. Historically significant sights include

India Gate, the President's House, Emperor Humayun's Tomb and the Qutab Minar.

Afternoon tour of Old Delhi will comprise the Red Fort, Jama Masjid mosque, Raj Ghat

(where Mahatma Gandhi was cremated), the Ashoka Pillar and the mile long Chandni

Chowk Bazaar. Overnight in Delhi.

DAY 06: - 30 JAN- Leisure time in Hotel followed by departure to railway station.
