




Residential Life at The Village 'A Home Away from Home'

Boarding lies at the heart of the school and is central to The Village International School's identity. Our students are encouraged to see every day as an opportunity, a chance to develop and grow and a chance to be the start of something; their journey as a lifelong learner begins the very moment they start their journey at The Village. The role of our Boarding Team is to plan out and put in place a program of activities and academic support that creates a natural balance for our boarders.

A typical school day starts with a morning PE session followed by a hearty breakfast. Sports coaches supervise field games like football, basketball, swimming and badminton in the afternoon for the boarders. Guided study hours are maintained every evening with support from the teachers of the school. Common rooms are equipped with indoor games like carom boards and table tennis tables.









The weekends at the hostel are a special blend of study, leisure and fun. Weekends are planned in advance by the teachers with educational trips, cinemas, exhibitions and other performances to give the boarders an experience of the local culture. Holidays are spent in recreational activities like team games, swimming and visits to nearby destinations. These activities range from going to the movies, concerts, educational visits to sightseeing trips.
